

District Swimming Pools Opening For Summer 2016

Summer is here! Community swimming pools at Stonegate Village Metropolitan District and Lincoln Park Metropolitan District are opening Saturday, May 28th. As a reminder, District residents are required to bring their Resident ID card for entry into the community pool complex, and for those individuals who do not have a current ID will be denied access. MPM Recreation will offer group swimming lessons at the Stonegate Village pool, utilizing the Aqua Kickz learn to swim curriculum. Group lessons are mainly for ages 4-12 and class sizes

are 3-4 students to one instructor. The ultimate goal of the group lessons is to give people the skills to be safe and enjoy swimming for a lifetime. All group lesson sessions are eight (8) half hour lessons staring at 9:30am, 10:00am and 10:30am, with classes scheduled for Monday through Thursday, and Friday as a make-up day. Please note that group lesson makeup days may be rescheduled due to weather, holidays, and special





events. Registration for group lessons opens on April 15, 2016, and the individual swimmer cost for attending the group lessons is \$75 per session per child. Additionally, Water Aerobics will be offered at the Lincoln Park Pool running from June 7th through August 13th. Please note that 2016 Summer Water Aerobics classes are scheduled for 8am to 9am on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday mornings, with a cost for the season is \$50 and will not be prorated.

New Direction In District Management For Improving Operations

On April 1, 2016, the Stonegate Village Metropolitan District announces a change and new direction in District operations and management, from a third party contract to a fulltime, onsite, and in-house management staff, effective July 1, 2016. Recently, the Board of Directors examined the increasing needs, requirements and future expansion of District services. The overall assessment and subsequent determinations by the Board of Directors were based on improving operations and providing more responsive support for District's residents, commercial businesses and customers. Therefore, the Board of Directors decided to move forward with the hiring of a fulltime, onsite, and in-house district manager and support staff. In support of this decision, the District offices will reside in the Activity Center, which is the smaller original building on the north side of the Stonegate Pool Complex.





Additionally, the District reviewed the overall impact for the repurposing of the Activities Center rental facility, and except for a few meeting events, the District has coordinated to move all remaining 2016 reservations to the District's Community Center rental facility. The new management staff will start overseeing District operations on July 1, 2016. In the interim, Community Resource Services (CRS) of Colorado will continue supporting the District by overseeing the contracted management services through June 30, 2016, which will help support and reinforce current operations, as well as assist the transition and change over to the new district manager and staff. These District services are maintained and operated by funds received through property taxes or fees, and are used for the operation, maintenance, and long-term replacement of District facilities, resources and infrastructure.
